Martin Fitchet, M.D., is Head of Global Public Health (GPH) at Johnson & Johnson. He leads an organization fully-dedicated to addressing some of the highest unmet needs and healthcare challenges facing the world's most vulnerable and underserved people, with a focus on tuberculosis, HIV, mental illness, neglected tropical diseases and vaccines to prevent COVID and Ebola. Originally joining Johnson & Johnson in 2000, Dr Fitchet assumed positions of increasing responsibility in Janssen R&D, including Global Therapeutic Area (TA) Head for Cardiovascular & Metabolism, Chief Operating Officer and Global TA Head for Pulmonary Hypertension. Dr. Fitchet also led Global R&D for Johnson & Johnson Medical devices, across the three Medical Devices franchises: DePuy Synthes Orthopedics, Ethicon General Surgery, and Cardiovascular & Specialty Solutions.

Dr. Fitchet has also held scientific leadership positions in Medical Affairs and Research & Development in metabolism and diabetes for Sanofi Aventis and Novartis.

Having earned his degree at the University of Nottingham Medical School in Nottingham, UK, he became a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of England in 1995, and later a member of The Faculty of Pharmaceutical Medicine in London, UK.
